



What has Intercambio accomplished thanks to your support?

In 2011 Intercambio:

- Connected **420** volunteers with over **1,000** adult English learning students from **45** countries.
- Helped **33** students receive their citizenship!
- Facilitated **22** “**Building Cultural Awareness**” workshops to **450** people including Sister Carmen Center, Mental Health Partners, I Have a Dream Americorps members, and the Center for People with Disabilities.
- Facilitated and promoted resource workshops on **budgeting, laws, First Aid, nutrition and more** to **400** immigrants.
- Provided courses on **financial literacy, English for Entrepreneurs, and computer literacy** for **60** immigrants.
- **Partnered** with seven schools in Boulder County to offer **English classes to parents** at Uni Hill, Casey, Sanchez, Skyline, Rocky Mountain, Central, Boulder High, Angevine, and Spangler.
- **Collaborated with and provided group English classes** at the following locations: 5 Boulder Housing Partners sites, Casa de la Esperanza, Boulder and Longmont Parenting Place, Safehouse, Boulder & Lafayette Public Libraries, two churches in Longmont, Longmont Senior Center, and the OUR Center.
- Strengthened its partnership with SWAP at CU to **connect 100 immigrant workers with 80 University students**. SWAP received the only 2011 **NOVA award** for innovation from the Community Foundation Serving Boulder County.
- Fostered intercultural exchange for **1,700** people annually through **community events** such as potlucks and park clean-ups.
- Distributed over **20,000** copies of the publication we created, *What Every Immigrant Needs to Know*, to **200** organizations nationwide.
- **Trained 250** adult educators nationwide at **8** conferences on how to train volunteer teachers and to teach laws and discuss cultural differences using *What Every Immigrant Needs to Know*.
- Shared its model, including our volunteer training and curriculum, with organizations in states including **Michigan, Georgia, Missouri, Rhode Island, California, Oklahoma and Arizona**.
- **Completed the first two levels of our revised and improved English curriculum**. This project has lasted 3 years, and we are scheduled to finish all 6 levels in June 2012.
- Helped hundreds of people get fit through our **world party dance exercise classes!** These take place at our Boulder office and at the YMCA in Longmont.
- **Rebranded** the organization, **changed our name** and developed a **new logo** to better reflect what we do, which is unite communities ☺. Although we serve many Spanish speakers, we serve people from 45 countries, and despite popular belief **you don’t need to speak Spanish to be able to be a volunteer teacher**.
